<p style="text-align: center;">Introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce the main characters. • Introduce the story setting. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sunny is a Meerkat who lives in the Kalahari Desert. • He has sandy, light brown fur with deep dark eyes. • He lives with his big family.
<p style="text-align: center;">Build-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop the characters and the setting. • This is the points that lead up to the problem. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sunny has grown tired of his home and family. He thinks it is too busy and he wishes he could go elsewhere.
<p style="text-align: center;">Problem</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is the problem that the character faces? • How do they react? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sunny leaves his family to visit others, writing letters home along the way. • He finds problems with each place he visits and starts to wish he was back home.
<p style="text-align: center;">Resolution</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How the conflict is resolved and the story ends. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sunny returns home and is happy.
