

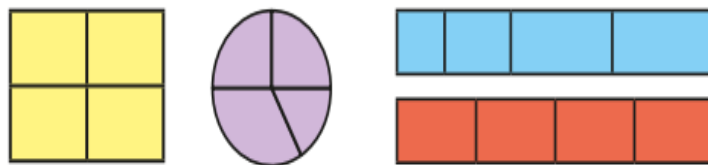
Learning update - 14.2.24

English - Year 4 have been researching about Brass Instruments to produce an information booklet.

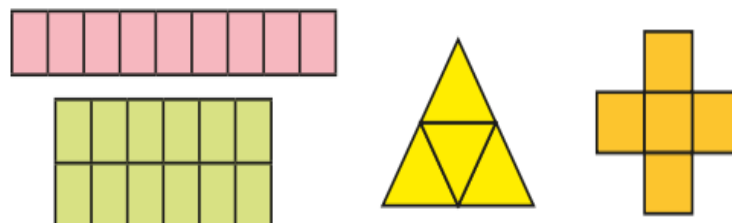
