



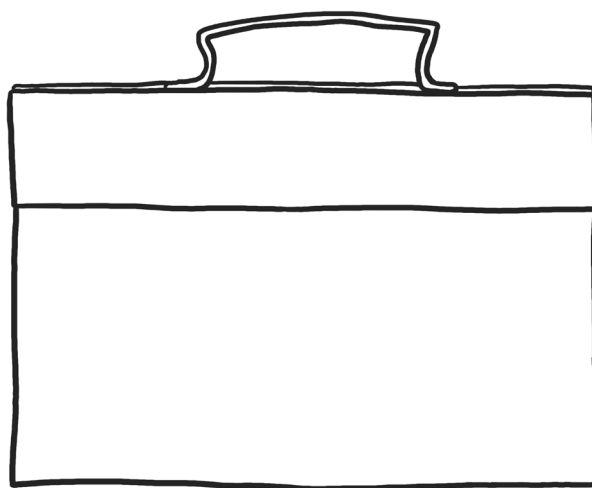
Choosing a Material

Remember to label it to show which material you have chosen!

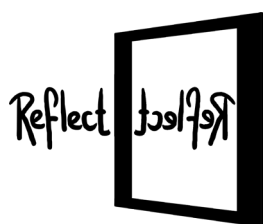
