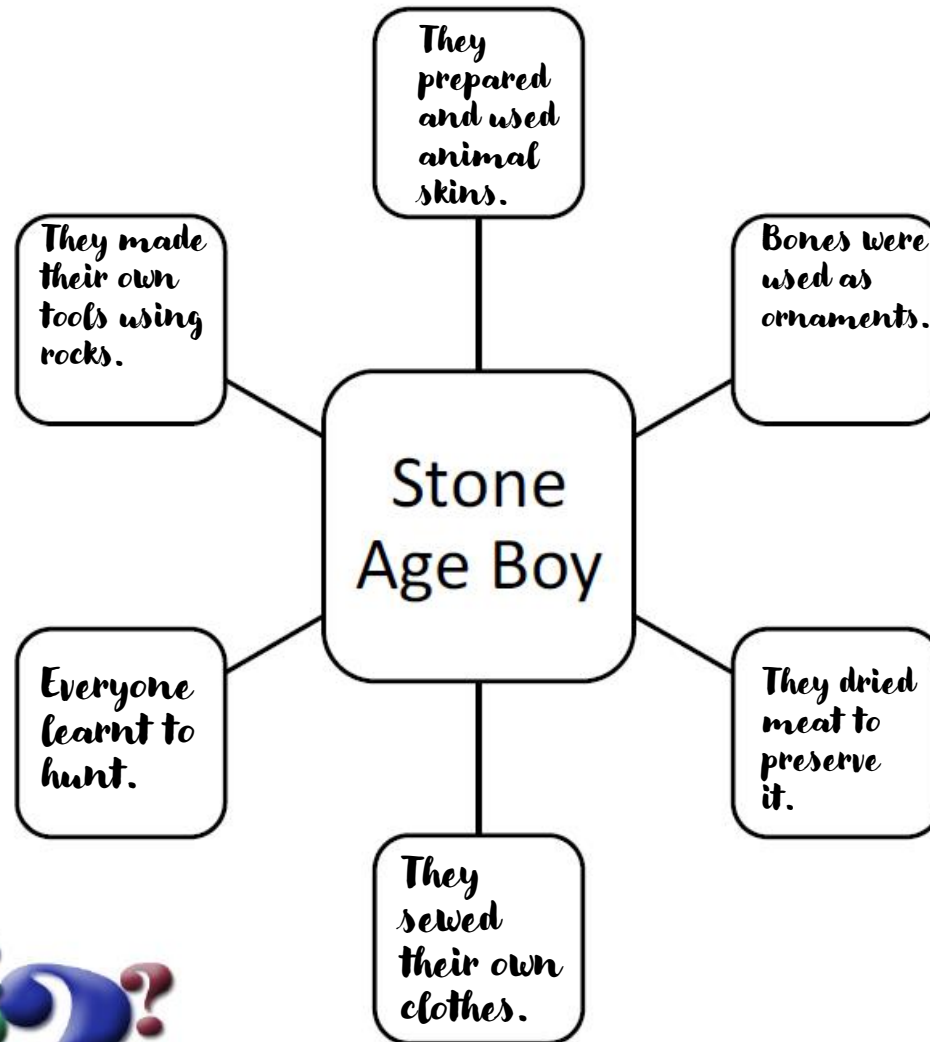
## LO: Can I make predictions about a text?

- Find other synonyms to this word. Why has the author chosen to use this word? (wandering)



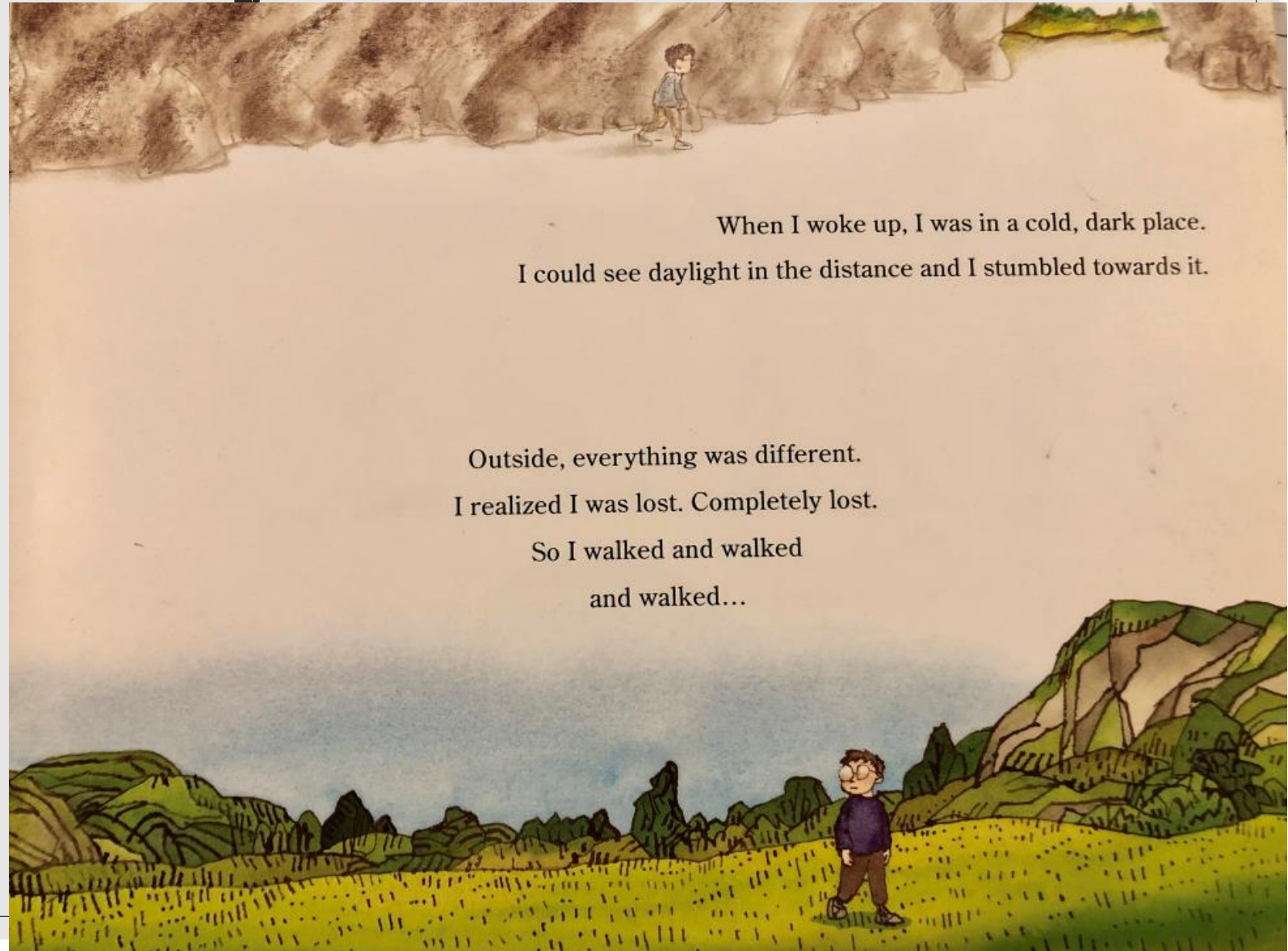
# Stone Age Boy - Can I explore vocabulary - adjectives?

- What is the effect of the lay-out?

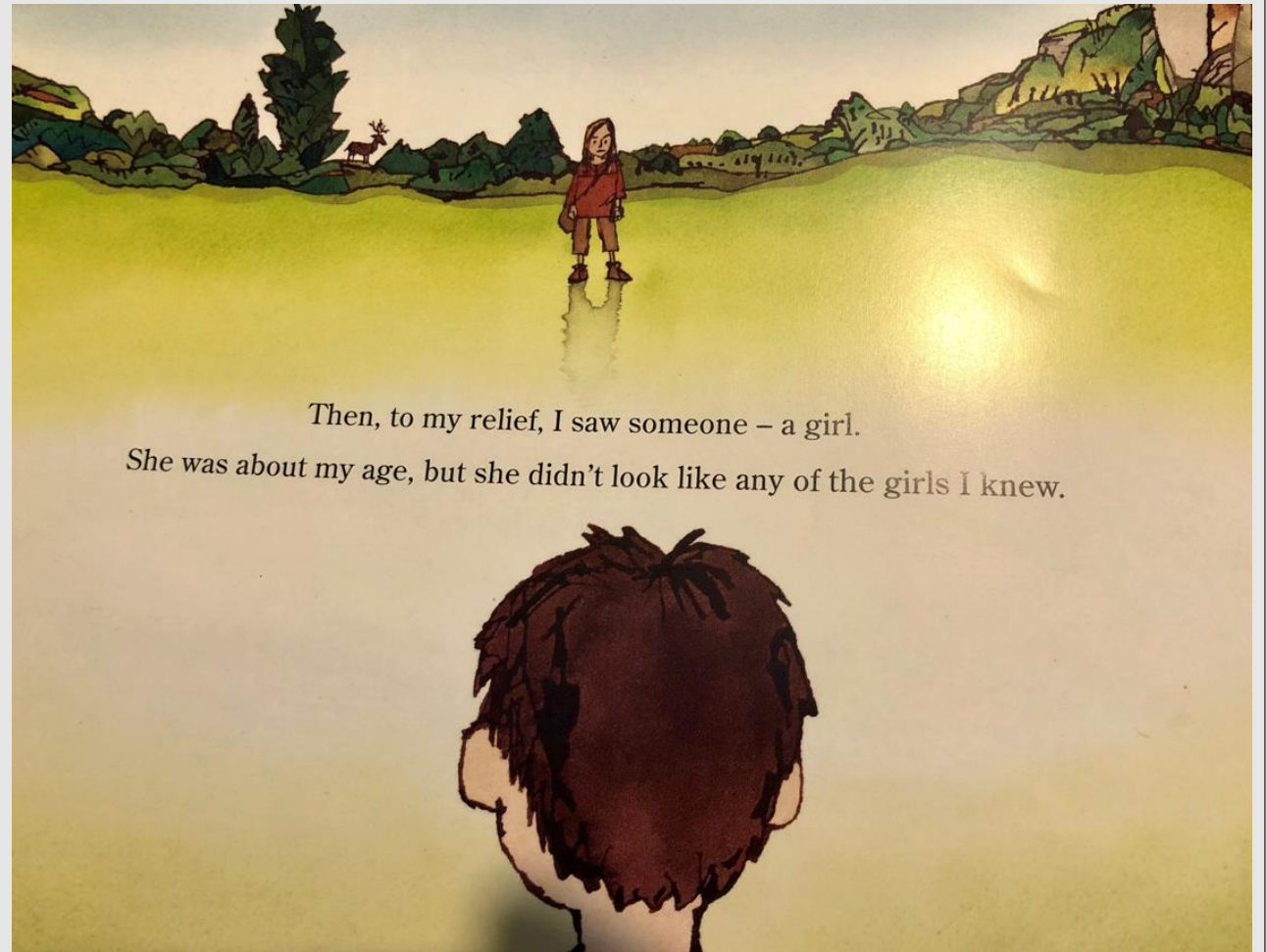
# 14.1.21 Can I make inferences about a character?
